The Arabic alphabet is composed of twenty-eight consonants, all of which are written, as in most Eastern languages, from the right hand to the left. Each consonant assumes a different form according to its position at the beginning, middle, or end of the word. On the next two pages the various forms are placed in separate columns and show how each character is written respectively -

When totally unconnected with any other letter;

When at the end of a word, or joined only to the letter preceding;

When connected with the preceding and following letters;

When at the beginning of a word, or joined only to the letter following.

Other ligatures are يـ، حـ etc., etc.

Pronunciation of the Arabic Letters

- ١ Alif has no sound of its own, but is pronounced as a, i, or u, according to the vowel above or below it. When not vowelled it is only a sign lengthening the preceding vowel.
- ٢ \bar{B} like the English b.
- ٣ \bar{T} like the English t.
- ٤ \bar{Th} like the English th in 'thought'; it is often pronounced like t.
- ٥ Jeem like j in 'jam'; in Egypt hard like g in 'garden'.
- ٦ \bar{H} is always a strong aspirate with friction.
- ٧ $\bar{K}\bar{h}$ is a guttural aspirate like ch in the German ich or the Scotch word 'loch'; kh always represents one sound.
- ٨ $\bar{D}\bar{l}$ like the English d.
- ٩ $\bar{D}\bar{h}\bar{l}$ like th in 'that'; dh is always one sound.
- ١٠ $\bar{R}\bar{a}$ like r in 'rural', always sounded.
- ١١ $\bar{Z}\bar{a}$, zai, or zain like the English z.
- ١٢ Seen like s in 'some'.
- ١٣ Sheen like sh in 'sheep'.
- ١٤ $\bar{S}\bar{ad}$ like a hard hissing s as in 'hiss'.
- ١٥ $\bar{D}\bar{ad}$ like a hard d, as in 'rod'.
- ١٦ $\bar{T}\bar{a}$ like a hard t, as in 'toss'.
- ١٧ $\bar{Z}\bar{a}$ like a dental z.
- ١٨ Ain is a guttural, peculiar to the Semitic languages, which can only be learned by ear; it sounds like the bleating of a goat (*maz*). When it begins a syllable we shall denote it by a spiritus asper (') before a vowel, or when silent after a vowel.
- ١٩ Ghain a hard guttural produced as in the effort of gargling and sounds similar to ghr.
- ٢٠ $\bar{F}\bar{a}$ like the English f.
- ٢١ $\bar{Q}\bar{af}$ like a broad k, produced as in imitating the cawing of a crow.
- ٢٢ $\bar{K}\bar{af}$ like the English k.
- ٢٣ $\bar{L}\bar{am}$ like the English l.

- ʃ Meem like the English m.
- ʒ Noon like the English n.
- χ like h in 'house'; if used as a grammatical termination it has two dots over it (ȝ) and has the sound of t when followed by a word beginning with vowel sound.
- ʒ Waw has the sound of the w in 'water', or of u in 'put'.
- ȝ Ya sounds like y in 'yard'.

) When , and ȝ are not vowelled, they are then only signs of lengthening the preceding vowel, u or i, or of making the diphthongs au and ai respectively.
